Participants learn how to be better leaders, how to work with teams and lead others, and how to develop and achieve objectives. Wood Badge combines the most current leadership skills used by corporate America with the best of successful outdoor leadership programs and more than 100 years of Scouting experience. Leadership skills developed through Wood Badge, while obviously applicable to Scouting, will also help participants be more effective leaders at work, at home, or in other volunteer roles.

Requirements:

You must be a registered adult Scouter with basic training for your particular Scouting position and any Outdoor Skills training appropriate for your position. There are no special physical or outdoor abilities required. You must be able to have fun!
