How to Earn a Patch

- 1. Collect items from family, friends and neighbors. Visit goodwillindy.org/donate/guidelines to see what Goodwill accepts.
- 2. Fill a 13-gallon bag or copier box with donations. Bring it to any Goodwill location. Large items (e.g., furniture) are also accepted. Find the nearest location at goodwillindy.org/locations. Hours are 9 a.m.-9 p.m. Monday-Saturday, 11 a.m.-7 p.m. Sunday.
- **3. Tell the attendant to count the donation for the Boy Scouts.** Don't forget this step! The attendant will log the donations and credit the Boy Scouts.
- 4. Ask for a paper donation receipt. Use it to report donations to your Scout leader.

Goodwill Rewards

If a Scout's family member has a Goodwill Rewards Card, the Scout may present the Rewards Card to the donation attendant to earn rewards and track donations online.
