### Elimination of \$1.00 Transfer Fee is Announced by BSA National

On July 19, 2013, the BSA National Council temporarily waived the \$1 registration transfer fee for adults and youth in the traditional units through December 31, 2013.

**Effective January 1, 2014, all registration transfer fees will be eliminated.** This means that adults and youth in traditional units, in Exploring, and our non-unit registrants, will no longer have to pay a transfer fee. BSA systems and forms will be revised to match this change in policy effective January 1, 2014.

# Registration Is Still Open for 2014 Programs at the New Summit High Adventure Base

Programs begin June 8, 2014, and are open to registered Scouts and Venturers who are at least 13 years old by September 1 of the year they attend, and their registered leaders. After completion, the form in the back of the workbook must be completed and sent to <a href="https://www.pray.pub">www.pray.pub</a> to obtain the pocket certificate. This certificate may then be brought to the trading post to obtain the youth religious knot.

#### Adult Religious Knot

Adults must be nominated for this award by someone at their church or by someone in the Boy Scouts. The nominated adult must have 5 years of service in the Boy Scouts and must have held a position of service at their church for 5 years. There is a form available through <a href="https://www.pray.pub">www.pray.pub</a> that must be filled out and sent to this organization with a letter stating why the nominee should be given this award.
