## **University of Scouting - March 19**

## Scoutmaster Specific and Intro to Outdoor Leadership Skills Training - April 8-10

## Wilderness First Aid Training - April 15-17

While it contains substantial medical information and teaches skills required for medical emergencies in the wild, the deeper purpose is to train participants to manage acute situations.
