Steps to Attend the Fall Camporee At Cary Camp

Step#1 Register your Unit on Campmaster

Step #2 Make sure you read this guide completely

Step#3 Everyone attending with your unit

needs to have a BSA Health Form.

(full is nice, but Parts A & B will work)

Anyone that has not followed these steps will not be permitted to enter the Camporee.

Camporee Logistics

Leave No Trace Camping

Scouts should leave areas better than they find them. We request that troops be sure to keep their grounds clean throughout the weekend, and take their trash out with them when they leave.

Ground Fires

Ground fires are not allowed. You can do your cooking on above ground fires pits, camp stoves or grills. There are some fire pit areas that can be used. There is no restriction on your fuel; you may use LP, wood, or charcoal.

First Aid

A Health Officer will be on hand for emergency situations on Saturday.

Restroom Facilities

There will be Restroom facilities available.

Water

Water will be available close to the camping area.

Parking & Traffic

Parking will be in the parking lot. Only vehicles towing trailers will be permitted to go to the camping areas, and be allowed to stay.

Check - In

Check in will be at the Main Parking Lot.

Trailers will be parked in the camping area; tow vehicles will be allowed to stay with the trailer.

Cars will be in the parking lot.

Weather

All events will be outside and may be affected by weather, so be prepared.

Camping

You will be assigned a camping area at check-in. All tents need to have "No Flame in Tent" signs. Each unit must have a fire bucket filled with either sand or water. Each unit needs to have a Fire Extinguisher. Each Unit is responsible for their own food and cooking equipment. We also ask that you bring your Troop Flag to display at your campsite.

No vehicles in the campsites.

<u>Signal Towers</u> – free standing, lashing only no screws nails, or modern hardware, towers should not be over shoulder high on Chas, and only one Scout on it at a time. Follow the field book & guide to safe scouting.

<u>Flag Pole</u> - free standing, lashing only no screws nails, or modern hardware, the taller the better, but be safe.
